Style Tip

Find your natural waist.

Your natural waist is usually the narrowest part of your torso, and where your body bends when you lean to the side.

Clothes highlighting this area help create proportion and the illusion of longer legs, especially when combined with high-waisted bottoms or a belt.

Bonus Tip

Tailoring is your secret weapon.

A simple \$50 nip and tuck can take a high-street piece and make it look designer.

Need ideas? Start with,

- Shortening sleeves or pant hems
- Nipping in the waist of a blazer or dress
- Taking in the sides of a top or blouse

It's not about having a different body- it's about making your clothes work for *your* body.





Secret #2: Know Your Colour Palette

- **2–3 base neutrals** (e.g. navy, camel, ivory, charcoal, soft white)
- **2–3 accent colours** that bring you to life (e.g. emerald, blush pink, rust, teal)

Sticking to your colour palette reduces overwhelm, speeds up dressing, and ensures everything works *together*—no more clashing tones or mismatched outfits.

Before

Wearing a cool-toned beige on warm skin = dull, sallow, lifeless

After

Soft camel or warm terracotta = complexion looks radiant, eyes pop, the outfit feels intentional

Style Tip

Find Your Undertone.

Which colours suit you best?

Start by identifying your undertone: warm, cool, or neutral.

You can use this simple jewelry test,

1. Stand in natural daylight without any makeup on.
2. Hold a piece of gold jewelry near your face.
3. Then, hold a piece of silver jewelry and compare the two.

If gold makes you look more vibrant, you likely have warm undertones.

If silver looks better on you, you're probably cool-toned.

If both gold and silver look equally good, congratulations! You likely have neutral undertones, which means you can wear a wider range of colours.





Secret #3: Balance Your Proportions

Effortless style is not about concealing your body or wishing for a different shape; it's about embracing your natural silhouette and utilising it to achieve visual harmony.

When you dress in a way that highlights your proportions, your clothes elevate your presence instead of distracting from it. Many times, when an outfit feels "off," the problem isn't the colour or the print; it's the proportions.

The Rule of Thirds (Not Halves)

One of the most flattering principles you can use is the **Rule of Thirds**.

How it works:

Rather than dividing your outfit into two halves (which can visually "cut" your body and make you look shorter or boxier), aim to split your look into **1/3 and 2/3**- either with the top taking up one-third and the bottom two-thirds or vice versa.

This golden ratio helps create length and flow and works beautifully on every body shape.

Proportion in Action

Before

A long, untucked tunic over mid-rise jeans hides your waist, makes the top half too long, and your legs appear shorter.

After

A slightly cropped knit or tucked-in blouse with high-waisted pants. This outfit highlights your waist, elongates your legs, and balances your frame.

Style Tip

Tuck It In

Tucking in your top- even just a front tuck- works magic on your silhouette. It visually shortens the torso and lengthens the legs, almost always resulting in a more flattering, elongated shape.

Bonus Tip

Want to define your waist even more?

Add a belt! This will draw the eye to your centre and help anchor your outfit.

A Note on Confidence
